## ADULT DAY SERVICES

At our Adult Day Centre, we provide supervised social, recreational and therapeutic programming for seniors and/or adults with disabilities who are unable to attend regular community activities because of physical and/or cognitive impairment, including dementia.

Our goal is to support and encourage our clients' independence and optimal functioning and to ensure their dignity is maintained. We provide programming that reflects our clients' interests, cultures and functional abilities. Montessori-based activities and Snoezelen therapy are our specialties. We are able to support clients with complex care needs, including those with challenging behaviours and/or who require assistance with feeding, toileting, medications and transfers.

Occasionally, we offer scheduled 24-hour service designed to meet the needs of the caregivers and clients attending our Adult Day Centre. This service provides caregivers the opportunity for much needed respite.

## CASE MANAGEMENT

Our friendly and professional case workers conduct comprehensive assessments, determine eligibility for admission in the program and collaborate with clients/caregivers to meet identified needs. Case workers are available to provide assistance and supportive counselling in response to identified needs or crises.

We offer our services in various languages, including Italian, Portuguese, Somali, Spanish, Urdu, Vietnamese and others.

There is no fee for these services.

## TRANSPORTATION

We provide personalized door-to-door rides for those within our transportation boundaries. Our wheelchair accessible bus and two vans with walk-on ramps make transportation easier for those with mobility issues.



## ALZHEIMER SOCIETY OF TORONTO

The Alzheimer Society of Toronto (AST) has a satellite clinic at our location.

The role of AST is to offer support, education and information to people with dementia, their families and their caregivers; increase public awareness of dementia; promote research; and advocate for services that respect the dignity of the individual.

AST social workers and the public education coordinator provide free dementia support to anyone, whether you're a person with dementia or their family member, friend, caregiver or the general public. Our services include:

- Workshops, active living programs, Music Project and social events
- Access to specially trained social workers who are experts in dementia care and provide help to support those living with or caring for someone living with dementia
- Support groups tailored to specific needs

- A supervised, locked, safe and supportive environment
- Warm and bright activity rooms
- A range of programming and activities, including daily exercise, cognitive activities, crafts, special events, entertainment and more. Our monthly calendar is circulated to caregivers and is posted on our website.
- Montessori-based programs
- Individual program plans
- Person-centred care
- Snoezelen for sensory stimulation
- Access to behaviour support teams
- Access to foot care services and occupational/physical therapy services
- Transportation to and from the program within agency's transportation boundaries
- A light breakfast, a midday meal (soup, entree and dessert) and an afternoon snack. Meals are prepared by our full-time cook. Staff are available for those clients needing assistance with feeding. Our monthly menu is posted on our website.

- Shower facilities on site
- Caregiver support group
