



Mental Health & Justice Prevention Program



**The Prevention Program works
with individuals with mental
health challenges who have come
into contact with the criminal
justice system.**

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Prevention provides short-term case management services to individuals who live with mental health challenges and who are at risk of involvement with the criminal justice system. The goal of the program is to support clients in addressing their mental health needs and to help them navigate the criminal justice system. Service is provided for up to six months.

To be eligible for service the individual must:

- Be 16 years or older
- Have a serious mental health issue (concurrent/dual diagnosis or cognitive disability included)
- Have current charges, past charges or have been released from custody in the past year
- Be referred by police, probation or parole services
