## FOR PRIMARY CARE PROVIDERS SERVING PATIENTS IN WESTON-PELHAM PARK:

We are offering an opportunity for you to have better access to specialist and community services through the **SCOPE** (Seamless Care Optimizing the Patient Experience) initiative.

**SCOPE** is a virtual inter-professional health team that supports primary care providers through a single point of access. Family physicians and nurse practitioners registered with SCOPE can connect to local specialists, imaging, and community services, to serve their patients with complex care needs.
